Die **Eintrittsgebühren**, die das Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) – das indische Antikenamt – seit 1. Oktober 2001 erhebt, gliedern sich zweistufig: in **Monumente der Kategorie A** (= World Heritage Sites), Eintritt für Ausländer **5 Dollar** (oder wahlweise **250 Rupien**) (Eintritt für Inder 10 Rupien), und **Monumente der Kategorie B** (andere als World Heritage Sites), Eintritt für Ausländer **2 Dollar** (oder wahlweise **100 Rupien**) (Eintritt für Inder 5 Rupien). Ausnahmen von dieser klaren Regel bestehen in Agra, wo neben dem ASI (Archaeological Survey of India), zusätzlich die Stadtverwaltung von Agra, die ADA (Agra Development Authority), eine Abgabe von Indern (weniger) und Fremden (mehr) verlangt (die sogenannte Toll Tax). Desgleichen gibt es **vier**, von der ASI betreute **Weltkulturerbe Stätten** (World Heritage Sites), für die derzeit **kein Eintritt** erhoben wird, entweder, weil es sich um aktive religiöse Andachtsstätten handelt (diverse katholische Kirchen in Goa, Hindutempel Bridishwara in Thanjavur), oder, weil es der Hauptbahnhof von Mumbai ist, oder auch, weil das Kulturdenkmal so abseits liegt, dass niemand hingehen mag (Höhlen und Malereien in Bhimbetka, bei Bhopal). Neben den ASI-Monumenten sind in obiger Tabelle (die den Stand vom 12. April 2007 wiedergibt) auch die Sehenswürdigkeiten: **Jama Masjid**, Freitagsmoschee, Old Delhi, und **Palitana**, Gujarat, eine heilige Tempelstadt der Jains, aufgeführt, auch für diese zwei Stätten wird gegenwärtig **kein Eintritt** erhoben.
